



# 10<sup>th</sup> YAO conference

13.3. - 17.3. 2004 in Innsbruck

The YAO (Young Atom Opticians) conference is a European meeting held every year for young researchers, i.e. Ph.D. students and Postdocs, in the field of Quantum Optics. The aim of this conference is to give young researchers from all over Europe the possibility to present and discuss recent research results, as well as to get in touch with people from other research groups.

**Where and when:** The next YAO will take place in **Innsbruck, Austria, from 13.03.2004 until 17.03.2004**. It is organized by the Ph.D. students of the groups of Prof. Grimm, Prof. Blatt and Prof. Zoller at Innsbruck University.



**Program:** Besides approx. 25 regular talks given by the participants and two poster sessions, two outstanding researchers, Prof. Christophe Salomon (ENS, Paris) and Prof. Gora Shlyapnikov (AMOLF, Amsterdam), will both give an extended keynote talk. **Costs:** YAO 2004 will have a limited number of 60 participants and there will be a fee of 290 € (at most) per participant including full-board hotel and a social event. The fee is an upper limit and will probably be less than stated, depending on financial support by associated networks. In special cases the fee might be reduced further.
